

Payment Information

- Participation is open to teams paying the \$200.00 entry fee. Entry fee includes automatic entry for big fish.
- All entry fees are non-refundable after May 31, 2008
- Registration can be done online via Paypal at THEX-SERIES.com. Paypal registration subject to \$6.50 surcharge to cover fees.
- Registration can be sent to the Tournament Director @ 422 North Turner Road Youngstown, Ohio 44515.
- Teams must have their entry forms and money in by the Monday prior to the tournament. Starting positions are determined by order of registration. Last boat check for regular flights will be 30 minutes prior to first flight. Late entrants will be accepted up to ½ hour before the first flight time and received assigned boat numbers. Late registration fee is an additional \$20.00. Late arrivals will receive boat number after last flight.

Rules and Information

The following rules remain unchanged unless notified at the captains meeting. Interpretations of the rules are the responsibility of the tournament director and his committee and are not open to protest. Tournament Committee has right of entry refusal or expulsion for any reason.

Boats and Equipment

All boats will be inspected and must meet required USCG and state standards. Your boat must have all USCG safety equipment. Bait and tackle may not be passed between boats after the tournament has started. Only registered contestants are allowed to be on the boat during tournament hours. All boats must have liability insurance.

Marine Radios and Cell Phones

You must have a working VHF Marine Band radio. The official tournament channel will be channel 80. You may monitor any channel while fishing, but cannot transmit by radio, cell phone, or any other electronic equipment. Any type of transmission of information by any communicative device concerning any aspect of fishing is prohibited during the tournament.

Fishing Two Fights:

7:00 A.M. blast off to 3:00 P.M. check-in
7:40 A.M. blast off to 3:40 P.M. check-in

Waters open to fishing are the Ohio waters of Lake Erie. Competitors must not come in contact with other boats during tournament hours. The only exception is in an emergency situation. If a competitor's boat breaks down, another competitor made bring their fish to the weigh-in and assist with a tow. Any disabled boat must notify the tournament director by cell phone or radio. Fish must not be combined between teams. All fish must be caught with rod and reel. Fishing must be done from boats. Trolling and live bait are acceptable. Team size can be from 2 to 6 people. Maximum of 6 rods per team unless it is a 2 man team then the limit of 4 rods will be observed. There is no dead fish penalty. Fish do not need to be kept in a live-well. Tournament officials reserve the right to adjust the tournament times or cancel the event after a lengthy delay due to dangerous conditions. Canceled events will be rescheduled.

Weigh-in

Will be held at Huron Boat Basin—Huron River

Teams must be past the official check-in site (announced at Captain's meeting) before the end of tournament hours to weigh fish. Any team arriving late will not be allowed to weigh in. Check in site will be announced at the captains' meeting, Saturday at the Huron Boat Basin. Winners will be determined by the weight of their five largest fish (1.5 inch min. limit). Big fish winner will be determined by the weight of single largest walleye. Only one fish per team is eligible for big fish. After checking-in all teams must weigh their catch in a timely manner.
